2. Data protection

Anonymous data are data that cannot be traced back to you personally. If you call up pages and files within this offer and are requested to enter personal data, please note that this data transmission over the Internet is unsecured and that the data can therefore be read or falsified by unauthorized persons.

5. Cookies

Cookies are not set.

6. Log files

Among other things, log files store the IP address, the browser used, the time and date and the system used by a website visitor. We only store pseudonymized IP addresses of visitors to the website.

At the web server level, this is done by using the log file as standard instead of the visitor's actual IP address, e.g. 123.123.123.123 an IP address 123.123.123.XXX is saved, where XXX is a random value between 1 and 254.

The establishment of a personal reference is no longer possible.

- Mail server log: retention time is 7 days
- Backups: are kept in encrypted form for 14 days

7. SSL encryption

In order to best protect your transmitted data, the website operators use SSL encryption. You can recognize such encrypted connections by the prefix "https: //" in the page link in the address line of your browser. Unencrypted pages are identified by "http: //". All data that you transmit to this website - such as inquiries or logins - cannot be read by third parties thanks to SSL encryption.
